The purpose of the book is to provide a comprehensive overview of urinary fistulas, from the more well-studied and common cases (obstetric, colovesical) to less commonly encountered situations (kidney transplant, transgender patients). The chapters are thoughtfully organized throughout the book and provide useful information for all urologists, successfully incorporating current data and literature.

Audience

This book will reach a wide audience, including students, residents, and practitioners, and will be useful in any urology office. By providing a great overview of a wide variety of urinary fistulas, the book meets the needs of its intended audience. The authors are experts in the field and have credibility in the subject matter.
